



# The Flynn Report

**Greetings Friends, Constituents and Supporters:**

I have had a very interesting and educational summer, traveling across the country to see first-hand what is on the forefront for National and State policies. In July, I traveled to Atlanta to participate in the annual conference of the American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC). This impressive set of meetings examines current events using Jeffersonian principals of free markets, limited government, federalism, and individual liberty. I truly enjoy the opportunity to meet with Legislators from across the country, whose common vision is to develop policies that ensure the powers of government are derived from and assigned to the people and the sovereign states.

The following week, I arrived in Philadelphia to attend the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), of which I sit on the Executive Board. This was especially unique because the Conference made a point to debate and vote on whether or not to support Pelosi and Reid's plans to push nationalized healthcare through Capitol Hill.
