Rep. Flynn Testifies for Strong Public School Curriculum Standards That Embrace America's Judeo-Christian Heritage

AUSTIN, TEXAS — As the Texas State Board of Education (SBOE) met today in Austin to consider revisions to public school curriculum standards, State Representative Flynn (R-Van) joined with other conservative state legislators in submitting written testimony from the Texas Conservative Coalition (TCC), the conservative caucus of the Texas Legislature.

Rep. Flynn stated: "I am fighting to ensure that the Judeo-Christian heritage of the United States and Texas is taught to Texas public school students without being censored for political correctness." He continued: "The fact is that America is the greatest nation in the world and I believe Texas is the greatest state in the nation. Our message to all must be DON'T MESS WITH TEXAS."

The TCC letter reads, in part:

We value a strong system of public education that prepares students to be productive citizens of Texas with a full and accurate understanding of the history that created present-day Texas and the United States. We urge that the TEKS continue to reflect the Judeo-Christian underpinnings of our nation and society; that America's greatness not be undermined; and that history and historical figures continue to be taught to Texas public school students.

Rep. Flynn concluded: "Our curriculum standards must remain strong, reflecting the historical roots of our nation and state, as well as the individuals whose intellect and efforts made America and Texas exceptional and unique. These revised curriculum standards will impact the education of the next generation of Texans, and they must be accurate."
