Flynn Elected as Chairman of Texas Legislative Sportsman's Caucus *State Representative honored, looking forward to new leadership position*

Austin, Texas—State Representative Dan Flynn (R, Van) was unanimously elected as Chairman of the Texas Legislative Sportsman's Caucus today. The Texas Legislative Sportsman's Caucus is a bipartisan organization dedicated to providing legislators and other interested Texans with relevant information on public policy relating to a variety of wildlife, outdoors, hunting, fishing, and other sportsman related issues.

"I am honored to have been elected to this position. I have had the distinct privilege of participating as a member of the Caucus in previous years and was able to host an event this past June at Lake Fork in our District in an effort to demonstrate the importance of such outdoor facilities as the Lake Fork Marina to both the Texas House and Senate members in attendance," commented Flynn.

Texas was one of the 21 original state legislative sportsmen's caucuses that united to form the National Assembly of Sportsmen's Caucuses (NASC) in December of 2004. After functioning independently within their own state legislature, Texas lawmakers joined a common network to interact with legislative sportsmen's caucuses across the nation. Texas ranks 1st nationwide in number of sportsmen, spending and jobs. The Lone Star State's 2.6 million hunters and anglers spend \$6.6 billion annually and support 106, 000 jobs.

"As the new Chairman of the Sportsman's Caucus and avid sportsman that takes pride in all that District #2 offers, I am eager to work alongside my fellow legislators to a make a concerted effort to educate all of Texas about the positive impacts that Sport's related activities have on our state," Flynn said.
