that major employers like L-3 continue to encounter with the low level of simple mathematics and science skills attained by the incoming workforce. The goal of this program is to help the students understand that what their teachers are teaching them today will be very necessary to succeed in the workforce when they graduate. Upon finishing the tour, the Flynn Flyers are treated to lunch at CiCi's Pizza in Greenville by Representative Flynn.
